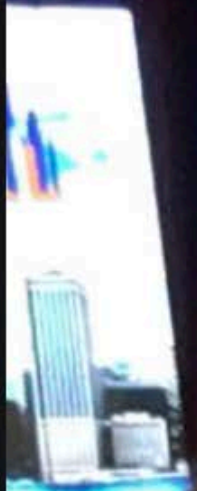

The vision of iwCLL is a world where all patients with CLL can be cured.

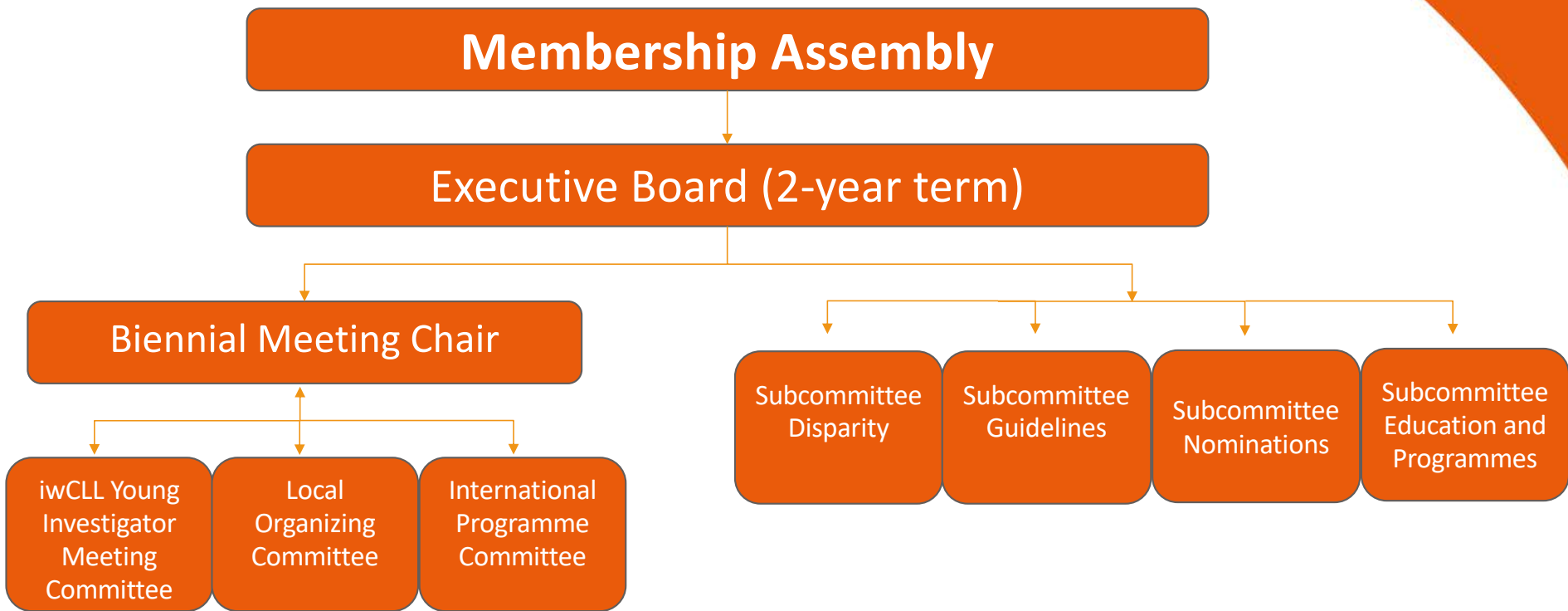
Mission
